APPOINTMENT OF AN RBED-REGISTERED SMME FOR LABOUR-BASED INSTALLATION SERVICES

Project: Supply and Installation of Electronic Security Equipment (Phase II Project) at the Civic Centre and NLEF Fibre Link Integration Project

1. Background

Multinet Systems (Pty) Ltd has been appointed by the Royal Bafokeng Administration (RBA) to undertake the Civic Centre CCTV Upgrade (Phase II) and NLEF Fibre Link Integration Project as part of its broader security modernisation programme aimed at strengthening surveillance capability, improving network connectivity, and enhancing integration with the Security Operations Centre (SOC). The project includes the installation of CCTV infrastructure, network cabling, fibre optic infrastructure, commissioning, testing, and associated security technology works. The project includes a commitment to allocate a minimum of 52.68% of the labour contract value for Electronic Security System (Phase II Project) and 74.69% of the labour contract value for NLEF Fibre Link Project to an RBED-registered SMME through subcontracting opportunities focused on labour-based activities.

Multinet Systems (Pty) Ltd hereby invites suitably qualified and experienced RBED-registered SMMEs to submit quotations for participation in the execution of selected installation works under this project.

2. Scope of Work

The appointed RBED-registered SMME shall provide labour-based installation services in support of the Civic Centre CCTV Upgrade (Phase II) and NLEF Fibre Link Integration Project. The SMME shall be responsible for undertaking the labour-intensive components of the project under the supervision and direction of the Principal Contractor, Multinet Systems (Pty) Ltd. The scope of work shall include, but not be limited to, the following activities:

CCTV Installation Support

- a) Installation of CCTV cabling and associated cable routing infrastructure.
- b) Mounting and installation of CCTV cameras and support brackets.
- c) Cable terminations and labelling.
- d) Installation of network racks and associated equipment. Provision of labour support during system commissioning and testing activities.



Fibre Optic Installation Works

- a) Trenching and excavation for fibre optic infrastructure.
- b) Installation of conduits, sleeves, and ducting systems.
- c) Fibre optic cable pulling and cable management.
- d) Fibre splicing support and fibre terminations.
- e) Installation of racks and fibre-related infrastructure.
- f) Assistance during testing, commissioning, and handover activities

General Labour Services

- a) Provision of suitably skilled and semi-skilled labour for the duration of the project.
- b) Support with material handling, equipment installation, housekeeping, and site preparation activities.
- c) Assistance with reinstatement and restoration of affected work areas following construction activities.
- d) Compliance with all project quality, safety, environmental, and regulatory requirements.

Health and Safety Requirements

- a) Ensure that all personnel are medically fit and trained for the activities being undertaken.
- b) Comply with all Occupational Health and Safety requirements applicable to the project.
- c) Provide and utilise the required Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) at all times.
- d) Adhere to site-specific health, safety, and environmental procedures and instructions.

Commissioning Support

- a) Site assistance during testing and commissioning.
- b) Equipment handling and logistics support.
- c) General installation assistance.

The successful SMME will work under the direct supervision and management of Multinet Systems (Pty) Ltd.

3. Mandatory Returnable Documents

Bidders must submit the following:

- a) RBED Support Letter (Not older than 3 months).
- b) Company Registration Documents (CIPC).
- c) Tax Compliance Status PIN.
- d) Valid Letter of Good Standing (COIDA).
- e) Certified ID copies of Directors.
- f) Proof of Banking Details.
- g) Company Profile detailing relevant/similar experience (proof must be submitted i.e Purchase Orders/Appointment Letters/Completion Letters).



- h) Proof of Public Liability Insurance – R5 000 000.00
- i) Proof of VAT registration if applicable
- j) Contactable references for similar projects (Minimum 3 contactable references).
- k) Completed pricing schedule.
- l) Health and Safety File (where applicable).

Failure to submit mandatory documentation **will result in disqualification.**

4. Skills Development and Enterprise Development

The successful SMME will receive support from Multinet Systems (Pty) Ltd through:

- a) On-site technical mentoring.
- b) Skills transfer and practical training.
- c) Provision of required PPE.
- d) Provision of specialized tools where necessary.
- e) Exposure to security technology installation methodologies.
- f) Enterprise development and capacity-building initiatives.

5. Contract Duration

The subcontract period shall coincide with the implementation programme for the Royal Bafokeng Civic Centre (Phase II Project) and NLEF Fibre Link Integration Project, currently scheduled for completion by **11 December 2026**.

8. Local Labour Requirement

Preference will be given to SMMEs that demonstrate commitment to employing labour from the Royal Bafokeng Nation communities and surrounding areas.

9. Closing Date and Submission Details

This RFQ shall close on the **9 September 2026** at **12:00 pm**.
