# REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ)

#### 1 INTRODUCTION:

The Royal Bafokeng Nation is seeking quotations from qualified local SMME contractors for the unblocking of a sewer pipeline. The pipeline in question runs from the Photsaneng Pumpstation to the Thekwane Wastewater Treatment Works (WwTW).

#### 2 INVITATION

Royal Bafokeng Administration (herein referred to as the Employer) hereby invites suppliers to submit a financial proposal for the Unblocking of Sewer Pipeline from Photsaneng Pump Station to Thekwane WwTW in the Royal Bafokeng Administration' area. Suppliers are required to study the requirements and specifications included herein and submit a financial proposal as part of their RFQ submission.

The site is located in Photsaneng starting at Photsaneng Pump Station (25°41'11.8"S 27°22'16.1"E) through to Thekwane WwTW (-25.640806, 27.352351). The project programme is summarised below:

### 4 Project Details: (See attached Layout Plan)

Pipe Diameter: 200mm

Pipeline Route: From Photsaneng Pumpstation to Thekwane WwTW

- **Flow Description:** Sewage is pumped from the pumpstation to a manhole, from where it gravitates to the WwTW.
- **Issue:** The pipeline repeatedly blocks somewhere midway. The investigation should establish the points of blockage and possible reasons for it.

#### 5 SCOPE OF WORK:

The successful bidder will be required among other tasks to undertake the following

- Establish and dis-establish a site camp
- Conduct a thorough investigation to locate the point of blockage. This might require excavations of the identified areas to locate the problem areas.
- Identify possible reasons for the repeated blockages.
- Provide a detailed reports of findings in the areas of blockage and document these properly.
- Propose and implement solutions to unblock the pipeline.
- Test the pipeline as required by SANS
- Ensure the pipeline is fully operational post unblocking.
- Testing and commissioning the works as required

#### 6 REQUIREMENTS:

Contractors must have relevant experience in sewer pipeline maintenance and unblocking as outlined below.

#### **6.1 TECHNICAL EXPERTISE AND CERTIFICATIONS**

- Plumbing Trade Qualification: A valid Red Seal certification in plumbing, demonstrating competency in sanitary drainage systems, is essential.
- SANS 10400P Compliance: Proficiency in adhering to national standards for drainage systems, including design, materials, and installation methods, as outlined in SANS 10400P.
- Advanced Equipment Training: Experience with specialized tools such as CCTV drain cameras, hydro jetting systems (3,000–8,000 PSI) technologies for diagnosing and resolving blockages.
- **Root Intrusion:** Experience in removing tree roots from pipes to prevent recurring blockages.

#### 6.2 REGULATORY COMPLIANCE AND LICENSING

• **PIRB Registration**: Registration with the Plumbing Industry Registration Board (PIRB) to issue Certificates of Compliance (CoC) for completed work

- **Environmental Compliance:** Knowledge of wastewater discharge regulations,
- Occupational Health and Safety Compliance: Knowledge of and compliance with Occupational Health and Safety regulations and specifications.

#### 6.3 PRACTICAL EXPERIENCE

- **Sewer Line Repairs:** Proven experience in repairing collapsed lines, replacing damaged pipes, and rehabilitating manholes
- **Emergency Response:** Ability to handle 24/7 emergency services for sewage overflows, including rapid diagnosis and resolution to prevent environmental hazards.
- **Collaboration:** Prior work with either RBN or municipal infrastructure, such as coordinating with authorities for inspections and approvals, is advantageous.

#### 6.4 DOCUMENTATION AND QUALITY ASSURANCE

- **Inspection and Testing**: Conducting water/air tests and gradient checks post repair to ensure compliance with standards.
- **Record-keeping:** Maintaining "as built" drawings and maintenance logs for future reference, as required by SANS 10400P.

#### 6.5 INSURANCE AND RISK MANAGEMENT

- **Public Liability Insurance**: Coverage for potential damages during excavation or repairs.
- **Health and Safety Protocols**: Adherence to occupational safety standards, particularly when working with hazardous materials or in confined spaces.

- Letter from RBED (confirming Registration not older than 2 months from the date of this RFQ/Advert)

- Quotations complete with the documents requested must be submitted on or before 6 June 2025 at 12:00. Any submissions submitted after the deadline will be rejected.

#### 11 TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

#### 11.1 GENERAL

- (a) Bids must be in South African rands
- (b) The Royal Bafokeng Administration reserves the right to call interviews with short-listed bidders before final selection.
- (c) The Royal Bafokeng Administration reserves the right to negotiate the price with the preferred bidder.
- (d) Bidders must provide details of physical address and contact numbers to enable the Royal Bafokeng Administration to assess the ability of the bidder to deliver on the submission made.
- (e) The Royal Bafokeng Administration is not compelled to accept the lowest price offer or any other bid

#### 11.2 BID INSTRUCTIONS

The bid document(s) have been drafted to ensure that essential information is furnished upon the correct completion of the document(s). Where there is insufficient space, or additional particulars are required to be furnished, such must be provided on a separate annexure, clearly indicated.

- (a) Bid document(s) may not be retyped or redrafted. Also, no photocopies of the original document(s) may be used.
- (b) Bid document(s) may be completed by mechanical devices; alternatively, black ink must be used to fill in the document(s).
- (c) The bidder must ensure that no pages are missing from the bid document(s) and that the pages of the bid are numbered consecutively. Royal Bafokeng Administration shall not be held liable with regard to claims arising from the fact that pages are missing or duplicated.
- (d) Bid prices must be quoted in South African currency and in the specified units, unless the contrary is clearly indicated.
- (e) All the documents herewith form part of the bid and failure to comply with any part thereof may invalidate a bid.
- (f) The Royal Bafokeng Administration may issue Briefing Notes during the briefing session which may contain amendments or information that may assist bidders in articulating their bids.
- (g) The Royal Bafokeng Administration requires as a condition of the bid that the compulsory explanatory meeting be attended by prospective bidders. This requirement will be clearly stated in the bid advertisement as well as in the documentation.

- (h) Bids must be submitted to the addressee before closing time. Bids submitted after closing time shall be considered late and will not be admitted for consideration.
- (i) The contractor/Service provider shall not abandon, transfer, assign or sublet a contract or part thereof without prior written consent of the Royal Bafokeng Administration.
- (j) It is an irrefutable condition of this contract that the successful bidder will have to negotiate and conclude a service level agreement with the Royal Bafokeng Administration
