

Must not operate within 'sin industries' (e.g., alcohol, tobacco, drug trafficking, etc.).

Must have annual turnover of R50m or less.

Must have been in operation for more than 2 years.

Must be willing to set aside at least 3 days per month to take part in business development support activities.
